Fence Posts

• wood, metal, fiberglass, or plastic



Plastic fence posts usually have built in clips for the wire.

Insulators

These are only necessary for metal or wood fence posts.

Insulated Gate Handle

- 14-16 gauge aluminum or steel
- polywire





The lowest wire is 10 inches from the ground. String at least 4-5 wires to at least 40 inches high.

Chargers/Energizers

- 4 types of chargers/energizers
 - solar powered
 - 12 volt battery
 - D-Cell
 - 110 Volt-AC

Ensure that you have a low impedance fence charger with 40-45 pulses per second.



Grounding Rods

Over 90% of problems with electrifying fences is attributed to insufficient grounding.

- 4 feet long and 1/2 inch diameter
- install in moist ground
- the better the ground, the better the shock
